Tips to safely use Bath & Body Works Wallflowers in your home

In order to ensure you get the maximum enjoyment out of your Bath & Body Works Wallflower, we want to share some important product usage information with you:

- Twist right (clockwise) to open the Wallflower. Twist left (counter-clockwise) to attach it to the outlet plug.
- Keep the Wallflower in the upright position once the cap has been removed. The unit's outlet plug is designed to rotate to ensure it can remain upright when plugged in.



- Bath & Body Works Wallflowers have a built-in safety mechanism (circuit breaker) that prevents them from overheating.
- If a unit heats beyond the pre-set temperature, it will automatically shut off and remain permanently disabled as a safety precaution. In the infrequent event that this would occur, just return your disabled device to any Bath & Body Works store for a replacement.
- Wallflower bulbs contain fragrance oils. While thoroughly tested and safe to use, these oils can cause damage to finished surfaces and certain types of plastics.
- Keep at least 12 inches of clearance above the plugged-in unit to allow the fragrance oils to disperse properly.
- If oil spills, be sure to wipe it up immediately.
